

# Wooden Spoon Santa

## **You will need:**

Santa template (see next page)

A4 Red card (1 piece makes two Santas)

(Felt, Fabric or Foam Sheet could also be used)

Disposable wooden spoon

15cm Pipe Cleaner

Cotton Wool

Double-sided sticky tape

Glue Stick

Marker pen to draw on features

1. Fold A4 card in half to A5 size.
2. Cut out the template and draw around this onto the red card, ensuring that the head end is touching the fold of the card.
3. Cut out the Santa, leaving the fold at the top intact.
4. Bend back the head of the front section of Santa at the neck and cut a small V in the neck space (as per template), large enough for the handle of the spoon to pass through.
5. Slot the handle through the card from the front so you have the handle enclosed between the back and front pieces of card and the head piece at the back of the spoon.
6. Wrap a piece of pipe cleaner around the neck and arrange into the shape of the arms.
7. Secure the back of the spoon to the red card with double-sided sticky tape and make sure you have an even overlap around the spoon.
8. Place a little glue on the inside of the sleeves, pipe cleaner and along the handle of the spoon and press together.
9. Glue around the red card overlap and the edge of the bowl of the spoon and arrange some cotton wool for the hair and beard.
10. Draw on a face and decorate the tunic with pens, glitter etc. if desired.
